Covid Security Policy for visitors

I will be holding a small pop-up exhibition of my drawings, paintings and prints for Artweeks, between 1st and 9th May 2021 at my home, Mill Lane House, Cassington. The display will be in the dining room which will be accessed directly through double patio doors from the front patio of the house. The room is large and will be well ventilated. For everyone's safety, visitors must comply with the following measures.

Arrival and registration

- Every visitor should ideally register their attendance for track and trace using the gov.uk NHS covid app. Please use your smartphone to scan the prominently displayed QR code on arrival. If you are unable to do this please ensure you supply your contact details on the single use comment cards. This information will be kept for 21 days after which it will be destroyed and not used for any other purpose.
- Hand sanitiser will be available and all visitors are required to use it on arrival.
- Masks, full-face visors or face coverings must be worn by all visitors and exhibitors.

Access and waiting

- Access to the exhibition will be limited to one household at any one time and a maximum of four people.
- Visitors will enter and exit through the double doors to the front patio and are requested to ensure social distancing if others are leaving or waiting to enter.
- If more than one group visit at any one time, there will be waiting areas in the driveway and if necessary the rear garden of the house. Visitors are requested to maintain social distancing at 2 metres between groups wherever possible.

The exhibition

- Single-use sheets with a brief biography and details of the work on show will be available. You may keep these or place them in the box provided for re-cycling.
- Before viewing touch hazards, such as sketchbooks and items in the browser, please re-sanitise your hands. Try to look with your eyes, and not with your hands!
- Should you wish to purchase work, cash can be accepted but visitors are asked to make contactless payments wherever possible - a card payment reader is available. Alternatively please discuss arrangements if you wish to pay by bank transfer.
- I'm afraid we are unable to offer toilet facilities other than in exceptional circumstances.

Housekeeping

- Doors and windows will be left open to allow maximum ventilation. An outdoor area with seating is available.
- Cleaning will take place every day, with high touch surfaces sprayed and wiped frequently.
